This is Laurie Snyder, Principal of Academics for grades 6-12, in the Lakeview School District. Thank you for your patience as we work through these unprecedented times in education and confront the realities of COVID-19. Currently, all Lakeview Schools will remain closed through March 27th and we would like to communicate our expectations for students as we move forward:

- Google Classroom is set up for every class, grades 6-12. Teachers may be providing resources and suggested activities through their respective Google Classrooms between now and March 27th. Students are encouraged to check in to each class on a regular basis and to keep their brains sharp by doing any suggested activities. Google Classroom is available on any device that can link to the internet.
- All HS students enrolled in CHS and/or AP courses should continue their learning through Google Classroom in order to prepare for the final exams.
- Current Seniors should make sure their Graduation Projects are in order and ready to go on the April 1 due date. Please see the Student Information Google Classroom for more information and resources for the classes of 2020, 2021 and 2022.
- Each student in grades 8-12 has access to a school provided Chromebook. If your student does not have an internet capable device at home and/or still needs a Chromebook, please contact LMHS to schedule a pickup time. If you do not have access to the internet, one option is to pull up to the curb outside of the LMHS building, where you can access our guest wi-fi at any time.
- The Student Information Google Classroom will continue to have updates for students and parents.
- Arrangements are being made to provide breakfast and lunch meals to students in the near future. This information will be communicated as soon as details are finalized.

Please know that our offices are operating within the building on an essential staff basis, but are available through calls to our office M-F, 8-4 and by email. We will do our best to return all calls and email correspondence within 24 hours. The situation is fluid and dependent on many factors outside of our control.
