

March 17th Informational Release

Good afternoon. This is Dr. Hendley Hoge the Superintendent at Lakeview School District. The schools are closed from March 16- March 27. At this time learning opportunities will be provided but not required.

We will open the Lakeview Middle-High School for students in grades 6 to 12 from 12:00 to 6:00, today. Oakview students and parents should not report, Oakview is closed.

Students may come to the school if they need to pick up any books, materials or instruments from their locker or band room.

Students are to report to the main entrance to sign in and leave. They are expected to practice social distancing and go directly to their locker or band room to collect their belongings. They are to leave in an orderly manner through the main entrance.

Grades 8, 11 and 12 only, if your child does not have a device at home to access the internet, and needs one, when they arrive at the school today they will be assigned a chromebook. You as a parent must be present and will be expected to sign paperwork at that time.

If your home does not have internet access, or if your child is unable to come in today and your child needs materials from the school call the school at 376-7911 **and follow the prompts for the school or office.** We will try to return phone calls within 24 hours.
