Recent brain research shows us that practice is necessary in order to master strategies that are critical to the success of the reading and writing process. The more students read, the more proficient they become at reading and writing. Summer is a great time to read to your children! It is also a wonderful time of year for students to read books for pleasure and to nurture a love for reading.

Reading aloud to our children also has tremendous educational benefits and can be a source of much enjoyment for students and parents. We strongly encourage parents to read aloud daily to and with their children. Read-alouds are not only enjoyable for beginning readers. They are just as essential for students in the middle grades. Reading comprehension improves as students listen to and discuss events, characters, and motivation. They learn to predict what will happen and they increase their vocabulary. In addition, the read-aloud time generates further interest in books.



Did you know that your child can sign up for a FREE library card through the Philadelphia Free Library and have access to THOUSANDS of books to download to their tablet or phone?



Here is how:

- 1. Go to: https://know.freelibrary.org/MyResearch/register/policy
 Sign up for a FREE library card through the Philadelphia Free Library. They will send you the library card in the mail. This typically takes a week or two.
- 2. After receiving your library card, download the Overdrive app to your device. →

 *Visit Overdrive.com for more information to download the app!
- 3. Sign up using email and password.
- 4. Find a library and link your library card.
- 5. Then, hunt for free books to download!!

Overdrive has many new and recent books as well as many classics. Some books are also available as audiobooks. You have two weeks to read the book before it is returned to the library. Like a library, there are only a certain number of copies of books, so you may have to wait if the book you are reading is very popular.


